New national standard curriculum shows the "Start curriculum".

You know, this is, so to speak, "connected curriculum" between elementary school and kindergarten. But I think it is not "NEW", it is "NATURAL".

During kindergarten, children follow the kindergarten's rules and schedule.

But as soon as they enter the elementary school, they meet many new things.

For example, teachers of elementary school keep attention to 1st. grade new pupils,

"DO NOT RUN DOWN THE CORRIDOR!", but pupils don't or can't understand teacher's attention. Pupils have studied DO NOT RUN DOWN THE CORRIDOR because it makes noisy and they make trouble other friends when they were in kindergarten.

Elementary school teachers must teach pupils following studies during kindergarten.

So elementary school teachers and kindergarten teachers must communicate about each curriculum and information of children.

I think "Start curriculum" means not "making something" but "consideration".
